

## Five Pillars of Islam Summative Assessment

This assignment is the summative assessment for this Unit. Your grade will be determined by the following: the relevance of your visuals, effort, neatness, color, and your description for each of the Five Pillars. Spelling and grammar will also count. Please follow the steps below:

1. Underneath each pillar, write the name of the pillar (ex. Shahadah). Please label the pillars in the correct order.
2. Inside of each pillar, create a drawing that relates to the requirements of that particular pillar. Be creative! (\*Please do not draw any images of Allah, Gabriel, or Muhammad as this is not permitted in Islam.)
3. Add color to each pillar.
4. On the back of the paper (inside the rectangular box), briefly summarize the requirements of each of the pillars. Use the guiding questions below to help focus your writing (in all likelihood, you will run out of space and you will need to continue your answer on white lined paper). Be sure to use complete sentences.
  - The First Pillar (Shahadah): 1. In your own words, what do Muslims need to declare in order to enter the religion of Islam?
  - The Second Pillar (Salat): 1. On a daily basis, how many times a day do Muslims need to pray? Where is it preferable for Muslims to pray?
  - The Third Pillar (Zakat): 1. What is Zakat? 2. Provide one reason why Muslims perform Zakat.
  - The Fourth Pillar (Siyam): 1. What is Siyam? (be sure to include when it is performed) 2. What is the reason for this custom?
  - The Fifth Pillar (Hajj): 1. Which city are Muslims expected to travel to? 2. Which object do Muslims walk around? 3. Identify one value that the Hajj is meant to promote.
