

## Museum Brochure Directions

A local museum has decided to open a new exhibit related to ancient Egypt. This new exhibit will feature the topic about ancient Egypt that you researched (mummification, housing, leisure, etc.).

Your task will be to design a brochure for this new exhibit. Your brochure will include a summary of the information that you researched and an illustration of an artifact that will be displayed in the exhibit.

### Cover Page Requirements:

- Write the name or title of your exhibit on the cover page. Please add color to your exhibit's title.
- Include a design or an illustration that is specifically related to your topic or related to ancient Egypt in general. Please add color to your design or illustration.
- Write your name in the lower right hand corner.

### Inside Cover Requirements:

- Create an illustration of an artifact that will be part of your exhibit. This should be an object (either authentic or a reproduction) related to your topic. Please add color to your illustration.
- Include a caption (a description of what the object is) with your illustration.

### Written Requirements:

- Write a topic sentence that explains what the exhibit is about. Be sure to identify the topic that you researched and the fact that the topic is related to ancient Egypt. See example below:
  - "Visitors to the exhibit will learn about the religious beliefs of ancient Egyptians." OR "Our museum is very proud to be able to share this exhibit about the farming methods practiced by ancient Egyptians."
- Using your research, summarize what you learned about your topic. When writing, please remember who your audience is: visitors to the museum that want to learn about ancient Egypt's history. You are the authority on this subject!
  - \*Please do not write in the first person.
  - If you need to, break up your summary into paragraphs (remember: one idea or topic per paragraph).
  - Include as much detail as you can
- Conclude your summary with a sentence that identifies at least two artifacts that visitors will encounter during their tour of your exhibit. See example below:
  - "Visitors of the exhibit will be able to view..." OR "On display at the exhibit is..."
- Please proofread your summary.

### Extra Credit Directions:

- If you would like to receive Extra Credit, you may add the topic that you chose (Leisure or Housing) to your brochure. Simply add a paragraph to your brochure that summarizes what you learned about the topic. Also include a visual (with a caption) related to the topic to the inside cover. Up to 10 points of Extra Credit may be added to your score for this assignment. The amount of points earned will be determined by the quality of your work.
